## **Federal Resource Corporation ranked 708 on Inc. 5000 America's Fastest-Growing Private Companies**

Erie, PA (August 17, 2021) – Federal Resource Corporation (FRC) has been ranked **No. 708** on the annual Inc. 5000 list, the most prestigious ranking of the nation's fastest-growing private companies. With a growth rate of **692%** over the past three years, FRC ranked #1 in government services in Pennsylvania and ranked no. 26 nationwide.

"We are extremely excited to be recognized again as one of America's fastest growing private companies," said Jeremy Young, CEO, FRC. Competing with more than 31 million small businesses in the United States, FRC's growth is staggering. It moved up 72% from an initial ranking in 2017 and this year 60% for the second consecutive year. FRC's rank has exponentially increased further solidifying its growth and capabilities. Many companies, including Zappos, Under Armour, Microsoft, and Patagonia first gained national exposure as honorees on the Inc. 5000.

"It's an honor to be recognized as one of the fastest growing companies in the country again," said Sarn Bien-Aime, Chief Revenue Officer, FRC. "We approach each opportunity to serve our customer's mission with discipline, expertise and an agile platform that forces us to listen first. This fundamentally changes *how* FRC engages and aggregates value to benefit our customers' and partners' missions."

According to Inc. 5000, the companies on the 2021 Inc. 5000 been very competitive within their market and this year's list especially proved resilient and flexible given 2020's unprecedented challenges. Among the 5,000, the average median three-year growth rate soared to 543 percent, and median revenue reached \$11.1 million. Together, those companies added more than 610,000 jobs over the past three years.
